WINEMAKING/MATURING The old vines are tended using traditional methods (ploughing, leaf culling

> and green harvesting). The grapes are fermented in cement vats using methods which conserve the typical characteristics of the terroir and yield

round, fruity wines with silky tannins.



VINTAGE 2011:

TASTING NOTES The deep ruby hue of this wine betrays its youth as well as the richness of the Merlot grapes, harvested at full maturity. The highly expressive bouquet exudes aromas of violets and liquorice evolving to black berried fruits - blackberry and cassis.

The silky attack gives way to a rich, chewy palate, with the smooth underlying tannic structure providing fine length. Definitely a wine for pleasure, displaying all the typical charms of this prestigious appellation and to be enjoyed over an informal meal with family or friends.
